

Overview: MIT Online Financial Aid System

The MIT Online Financial Aid System gives MIT students real-time access to their financial aid information for current and prior years.

Users can access the system through WEBSIS or at fadata.mit.edu, using their MIT certificates or their Kerberos username and password.

The "Home" page is the first page you will see when you log in. A brief description of the other pages can be found here. To navigate between the pages, click the dropdown menu at the upper left.

Funding is awarded through the traditional UROP Direct Funding process, and normal UROP proposal standards and requirements apply.

Prospective students will not be able to access this form, and may e-mail getaloon@mit.edu to report outside scholarships.
